

ORDINANCE NO. 08-0-3

**ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE TRUSTEE TRAINING PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, Section 6 of the Fire Protection District Act (70 ILCS 705/0.01 *et seq.*) has been amended to now permit any trustee of a fire protection district who completes a training program on fire protection district administration approved by the Office of the State Fire Marshall to receive additional compensation above the compensation otherwise provided in this Section. The additional compensation shall be equal to fifty percent (50%) of other compensation and that in order to continue to receive the additional compensation, the trustee must attend annual training approved by the Office of the State Fire Marshall on a continuing basis thereafter; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Pleasantview Fire Protection District have determined that their ability to administer the office of trustee will be enhanced by participating in this program and attending the required training; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance was approved at the regular meeting of the Board of Trustees on November 11, 2008, subject to the preparation of a written ordinance in customary form.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Pleasantview Fire Protection District, an Illinois municipal corporation, Cook and DuPage Counties, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION I**

Recitals. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance.

**SECTION II**

Establishment of Trustee Training Program. A trustee training program is hereby established whereby Trustees of the Pleasantview Fire Protection District may attend and complete a training program on fire protection district administration approved by the Office of the State Fire Marshall and may attend annual training thereafter as approved by the Office of the State Fire Marshall.

**SECTION III**

Compensation. Any Trustee of the Pleasantview Fire Protection District completing the trustee training program as approved by the Office of the State Fire Marshall shall receive, as additional compensation to what that Trustee now receives, fifty percent (50%) of such other compensation. That compensation shall be paid thereafter if the Trustee attends the annual training approved by the Office of the State Fire Marshall on a continuing basis thereafter.

SECTION IV

Separability.

- A. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the President and Board of Trustees of the Pleasantview Fire Protection District that the several provisions of this Ordinance are separable.
- B. If any court of competent jurisdiction should adjudge any provision or a part thereof of this Ordinance to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect any other provision or part thereof of this Ordinance including other parts of the provision declared invalid which are not specifically declared to be invalid in said judgment.

SECTION V

Repeal. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions hereof are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.

SECTION VI

Effective Date. This Ordinance, upon its passage and approval, is effective as of November 11, 2008.
