

RESOLUTION NO. 10-R-2

PREVAILING WAGE RATE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted "An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works by the State, county, city and any public body or any political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works," approved June 26, 1941, as amended, being 820 Illinois Compiled Statutes 130/1-12.

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Act requires that the Board of Trustees of the Pleasantview Fire Protection District investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics and other workers in the locality of said District employed in performing construction of public works for said Pleasantview Fire Protection District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Pleasantview Fire Protection District, as follows:

Section 1. To the extent and as required by "An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works by State, county, city or any public body or any political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works" approved June 26, 1941, as amended, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers engaged in construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the Pleasantview Fire Protection District is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in the Cook County area as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois as of June 1, 2010. As required by this Act, any and all revisions of the prevailing rate of wages by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois shall supersede the Department's June determination and apply to any and all public works construction undertaken by the Pleasantview Fire Protection District. The definition of any terms appearing in this Resolution which are also used in this Act shall be the same as in the Act.

Section 2. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction of the Pleasantview Fire Protection District to the extent required by the aforesaid Act.

Section 3. The Secretary of the Board of Trustees of the Pleasantview Fire Protection District shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the Headquarters of this District his determination of such prevailing rate of wage.


Section 4. The Secretary of the Board of Trustees shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any such person or association of employees who have filed their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination, stating the particular rates and the particular class or workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.


Section 5. The Secretary of the Board of Trustees shall promptly cause to be filed a certified copy of this Resolution with both the Secretary of State and the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.

Section 6. The Secretary of the Board of Trustees shall cause to be published, in a newspaper of general circulation within the area, a copy of this Resolution and such publication shall constitute notice that the determination is effective and that this is the determination of this public body.
